Horn Issues

Recently we have seen a high number of horn warranties. Upon inspection of the returned horns there was no trouble found on many of them.

Here are some tips on diagnosing possible horn issues:

- 1. Horn volume is variable and will be different between two motorcycles. Perceived low horn tone is not warrantable.
- 2. Water in the horn could also cause a low horn tone. It would be suggested to let the horn dry and re-verify function.
- 3. Verify wire routings, connections, proper ground, and voltage.
- 4. Check for binding horn mounts.
- 5. Proper torque on the horn fastener is also critical and should be verified.
- 6. The horn operation needs to be checked with the engine running.
